

Bomanite Corp to open Grand Prairie plant

Bomanite Corp., an architectural concrete and paving company out of Madera, Calif., has chosen Grand Prairie for its third U.S. manufacturing facility.

The company has leased a 30,000-square-foot building at 1249 Avenue R in the Great Southwest Industrial Park and expects to be open at the location by March 1. Other Bomanite plants are in California and Tennessee.

Bill Nichols, vice president of operations at Bomanite, said the deal wouldn't have happened without city and state support.
